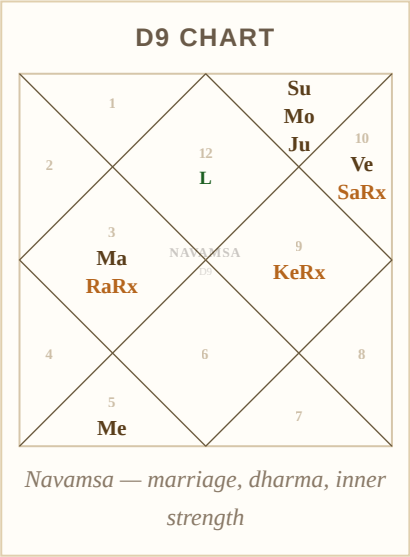
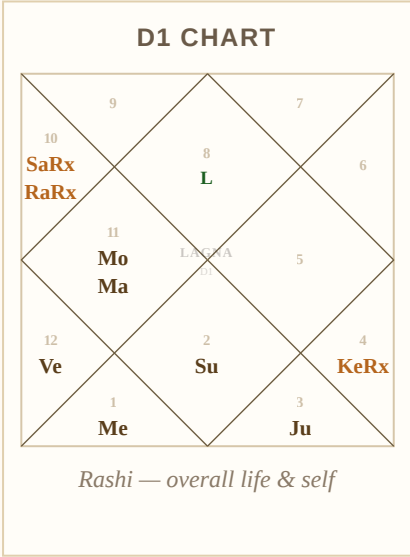

Mars also has **206.60** in sthana bala, **48.45** in chesta bala, and **15** benefic points in Ashtakavarga. This gives his action principle meaningful support, though it operates through a sensitive, adaptive and internally motivated water sign rather than through blunt directness.
- **Karan Kapoor:** Mars is in **Aquarius in the 4th house**, in Purva Bhadrapada pada 3. Its Shadbala is **386.48**, or **6.44 rupas**, with a strength ratio of **1.29**. Mars has **230.35** in sthana bala, **91.05** in chesta bala, and **15** benefic points in Ashtakavarga.
